1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 61,307.5 million in April 2021, increased by 99.0 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 24.3 percent compared with the previous month. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

April 2021 recorded a total exports value of TZS 2,470.2 million, increased by 11.2 percent compared to April 2020 and decreased by 29.5 percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 76.1 percent (TZS 1,880.2 million) of the total exports in April 2021 (table 2).

3. Exports by Top Five Partner in April 2021

Total


The top five trading partners for exported goods in the April 2021 accounted 71.2 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was China that accounted 26.0 percent (TZS 642.1 million) of the total export in April 2021 (Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

April 2021 recorded a total import value of TZS 63,777.7 million, which increased by 93.1 percent compared to April 2020 and decreased by 24.5 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 38.2 percent (TZS 24,355.4 million) of the total value imported followed by Food and live animals (19.5 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

April 2021 imported value of consumer goods was TZS 21,633.5 million which increased by 76.0 percent compared to April 2020 and decreased by 7.4 percent compared to previous month. Imports value of capital goods was TZS 12,179.7 million which increased by 88.3 compared with corresponding month of 2020 and by 1.9 percent compared to the previous month and Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 29,964.5 million which increased by more than hundred percent compared to corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 39.0 percent compared to previous month (Table 4).



6. Imports by Top Five Partner in April 2021

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the April 2021 contributed 75.9 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (45.9 percent, TZS 29,286.9 million) and Australia (10.3 percent, TZS 6,593.2 million).
