1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 94,923.9 million in December 2021, increased by 24.1 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and by 16.7 percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio decreased from 18.9 percent in November 2021 to 3.1 percent in December 2021. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

December 2021 recorded a total exports value of TZS 3,086.9 million, decreased by 10.3 percent compared to December 2020 and by 83.7 percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 71.6 percent (TZS 2,211.3 million) of the total exports in December 2021 (table 2).



3. Exports by Top Five Partner in December 2021

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the December 2021 accounted 70.4 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was Vietnam that accounted 23.7 percent (TZS 731.7 million) of the total export in December 2021(Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

December 2021 recorded a total import value of TZS 98,010.8 million, which increased by 22.6 percent compared to December 2020 and decreased by 2.3 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 30.2 percent (TZS 29,614.0 million) of the total value imported followed by Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (23.4 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for December 2021 was TZS 23,160.3 million which increased 19.6 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 4.8 percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 28,203.6 million which increased by 10.1 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and by 53.2 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 46,646.9 million which increased by 33.4 percent compared to corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 19.0 percent compared to previous month (Table 4).



6. Imports by Top Five Partner in December 2021

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the December 2021 contributed 80.1 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (34.2 percent, TZS 33,497.1 million).
