TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR DECEMBER, 2017

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar increased by 40.6 percent to **51,112** in December from **36,363** in November 2017 and 16.5 percent compared with corresponding month in 2016. Tourists from Europe continue to dominate the Zanzibar market which accounts 55.7 percent of the total visitors in December and posted a growth of 11.5 compared with corresponding month in 2016. In country wise, Italy (6,430) dominated the Tourism market by accounting 12.6 percent of all visitors entered in November, followed by South Africa (7.3 percent) and Scandinavia (6.7 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.2 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **41,944** visitors entered through Airport, among them **30,365** visitors came by international flights and **11,579** by domestic flights. The remaining **9,168** visitors entered through seaport, of whom **517** visitors came by Cruise Ship and **8,651** by Sea Ferries.

Generally, Zanzibar has received 433,474 visitors for the year 2017 which is an increase of **15.2** percent compared with the previous year. Almost three quarters (**63.5** percent) of all visitors in 2017 were from Europe. The visitors from Europe has increased by 18.1 percent compared to the last year. In country wise, Italy (51,978) equivalent to 12 percent of the all visitors in 2017 continue to dominate the market. Italians have increased by 11.1 percent compared to last year. About **361,645** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **83.4** percent while the remaining **71829** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **16.6**percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in December 2017, About 49,960 visitors equivalent to **98** percent of visitors came for holidays, followed by 'visiting friend and relatives' that accounts for less than one percent (0.7 percent).

Table 5 shows that there were **26,089** male (51.0 percent) and **25,023** female (49.0 percent) visitors in November, 2017. Both males and females increased by 53.4 and 29.3 percent by percent respectively compared with the preceding month.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that **4,764** (9.3 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **44,061** (**86.2** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **2,287** (4.5 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that more than half (52.5 percent) of the visitors stayed in the country either for seven or eight days. Less than one percent (0.8 percent) of the visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in November, 2017 was around Eight nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of December 2017 rose by more than one third (34.9 percent) compared with corresponding month in 2016 and decreased by 13.6 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from Russia greatly increased by more than hundred percent compared with the corresponding month in 2016. With the exception of Poland which prevailed a decrease in December, the remaining countries showed an increase compared with previous month. Other performances are shown in Table 8.

The total of **520,738** bed-spaces was available in December 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of 410,442 hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **78.8** percent (Table 10).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist:refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

(iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship;

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
