TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR MARCH, 2018

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar decreased by 15.6 percent to **39,592** in March from **46,935** in February 2018 and increased by 30.4 percent compared with corresponding month in 2017. Tourists from Europe continue to dominate the Zanzibar market which accounts 62.3 percent of the total visitors in March and posted a growth of 17.9 compared with corresponding month in 2017. In country wise, Italy (4,833) dominated the Tourism market by accounting 12.2 percent of all visitors entered in March, followed by America (9.7 percent) and Germany (7.6 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.1 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **34,912** visitors entered through Airport, among them **28,263** visitors came by international flights and **6,649** by domestic flights. The remaining **4,680** visitors entered through seaport, of whom **97** visitors came by Cruise Ship and **4,583** by Sea Ferries.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **138,944** visitors from January - March, 2018 which is an increase of **16.1** percent compared with the corresponding months (January - March) 2017. Almost two third (**63.7** percent) of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (14.1 percent) is a leading market for the first three months in Zanzibar tourism market. About **121,512** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **87.5** percent while the remaining **17,432** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **12.5** percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in March 2018, about 38,758 visitors equivalent to **97.9** percent of visitors came for holidays, followed by 'visiting friend and relatives' that accounts for less than one percent (0.7 percent).

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Table 5 shows that there were **19,182** male (48.4 percent) and **20,410** female (51.6 percent) visitors in March, 2018. Both males and females decreased by 21.4 and 9.5 percent respectively compared with the preceding month.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that **2,178** (5.5 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **34,610** (**87.4** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **2,804** (7.1 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (19.1 percent) stayed in the country for seven days. Only one percent (1.0 percent) of visitors stayed in the country for at least a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in March, 2018 was about Eight (7.8) nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of March 2018 rose by 18.5 percent compared with corresponding month in 2017 and decreased by 6.9 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from Russia greatly increased by more than hundred percent compared with the corresponding month in 2017 and by 16.2 percent compared with previous month. Other performances are shown in Table 8.

The total of **524,830** bed-spaces was available in March 2018. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of 306,868 hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **58.47** percent (Table 10).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist:refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization - UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

(iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship;

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
