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TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR NOVEMBER, 2017

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar decreased by 16.3 percent to **36,363** in November from **43,470** in October 2017 and increased by 15.2 percent compared with corresponding month in 2016. Europe remains as the largest market source of all visitors and posted an overall growth of 28.4 percent in November compared with corresponding month in 2016. In country wise, Italy (4,342) dominated the Tourism market by accounting 11.9 percent of all visitors entered in November, followed by Germany (10.4 percent) and Britain (6.9 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.3 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **30,502** visitors entered through Airport, among them **21,654** visitors came by international flights and **8,848** by domestic flights. The remaining **5,861** visitors entered through seaport, of whom **1,283** visitors came by Cruise Ship and **4,578** by Sea Ferries.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **382,362** visitors from January to November 2017 which is an increase of **15.0** percent compared with the corresponding months in 2016. Almost three quarters (**64.6** percent) of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (11.9 percent) is a leading market for the first eleven months. About **319,701** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **83.6** percent while the remaining **62,661** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **16.4** percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in November 2017, majority of visitors (97.3 percent) came for holidays compared to only 786 (2.2 percent) and 27 (0.1 percent) for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 5 shows that in November, 2017 there were **17,004** male (46.8 percent) and **19,359** female (53.2 percent) visitors. Comparing with the previous month males decreased by 19.5 percent and females decreased by 13.4percent.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6show that **941** (2.6percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **31,745** (**87.3** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **3,677** (10.1 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (26.2percent) stayed in the country for seven days. About one percent (1.2 percent) of visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in November, 2017 was almost Eight (7.9) nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of November 2017 increased by 34.9 percent compared with corresponding month in November 2016 and decreased by 13.6 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from Russia increased to 1,488 for the month of November compared with 341 visitors recorded in November 2016 and 1.109 visitors from previous month. Other performances are shown in Table 8.

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in November 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of 287,930 hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **54.1** percent (Table 10).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist:refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

(iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship;

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
