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TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR SEPTEMBER, 2017

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar decreased to **38,977** in September from **51,937** in August 2017 which is an decrease of 25 percent and increase of 19 percent compared with corresponding month in September 2016. Europe remains as the largest market source of all visitors and posted an overall growth of 24.4 percent in September compared with corresponding month in 2016. In country wise, Germany (5,101) dominated the Tourism market by accounting 13.1 percent of all visitors entered in September, followed by Italy (11.2 percent) and Britain (9.9 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.3 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **33,974** visitors entered through Airport, among them **21,308** visitors came by international flights and **12,666** by domestic flights. The remaining **5,003** visitors entered through seaport.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **302,529** visitors from January to September 2017 which is an increase of **17.9** percent compared with the corresponding months January - September, 2016. Almost three quarters (63.7 percent) of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (12.3 percent) is a leading market for the first nine months. About **251,366** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **83.1** percent while the remaining **51,163** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **16.9** percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in September 2017, a majority of visitors **38,143** (97.9 percent) came for holidays compared to only **620** (1.6 percent) and **19** (0.05 percent) for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 5 shows that in September, 2017 there were **16,528** (42.4 percent) males and **22,449** (57.6 percent) female visitors. Comparing with the previous month males and females decreased by 28.2 percent and 22.3 percent respectively.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that **758** (1.9 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **35,897** (92.1 percent) were aged 15 and 64 years and **2,322** (6.0 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (25.7 percent) stayed in the country for eight days. Only one percent (1.0 percent) of visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in September, 2017 was almost Eight (7.8) nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of September increased by 17.9 percent compared with corresponding month in September, 2016 and decreased by 24.7 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from Poland have increased 1.5times (152.9 percent) for the month of September compared with corresponding month in September, 2016 and increased by 15.6 percent from previous month. Other performance are shown in Table 8.

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in September 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, an estimate of **297,754** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **55.9** percent. (Table 10).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist: refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization - UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

activity remunerated from within the place visited. exercise of an

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland; (ii)

(iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship;

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
