TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR MAY 2020

Zanzibar received 197 visitors in May 2020 compared with 15,640 visitors in a corresponding month 2019 and 334 visitors in April 2020. Tourists from Europe continue to dominate the Zanzibar market by accounting 59.9 percent of the total visitors in May 2020. Among them, 99 visitors came by domestic flights and 98 by Sea Ferries. Other performances are as shown in (**Table 1 and Table 2**).

Generally, Zanzibar has received **157,545** visitors from January-May 2020 which is a decrease of **5.0** percent compared with the corresponding months (January – May) 2019. Most of visitors were from Europe (**69.9** percent). In country wise, Italy (12.3 percent) is a leading market for the first five months in Zanzibar tourism market. About **145,085** visitors entered through airport while the remaining **12,460** visitors entered through seaport (**Table 3**).

Information on the purpose of visit (**Table 4**) shows that May 2020, most of visitors (**82.7** percent) came for holidays followed by visiting friends and relatives (**10.7** percent). There were **125** males (**63.5** percent) and **72** females (**36.5** percent) (**Table 5**).

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in **Table 6** show that **12** (**6.1** percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **175** (**88.8** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **10** (**5.1** percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority (**31.0** percent) of all visitors in May 2020 stayed in the country for Seven days. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in May 2020 was about Five (5.4) nights.

The total of **537,075** bed-spaces was available in May 2020. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of **1,061** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **0.2** percent (**Table 9**).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist: refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; (iii)

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
