TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR JULY, 2018

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar increased by 42.6 percent to **53,087** in July from **37,235** in June 2018 and increased by 29.4 percent compared with corresponding month in 2017. Tourists from Europe continue to dominate the Zanzibar market which accounts 55.1 percent of the total visitors in July and posted a growth of 20.9 compared with corresponding month in 2017. In country wise, America (6,696) continued to dominate the Tourism market by accounting 12.6 percent of all visitors entered in July, followed by Britain (8.0 percent) and Germany (7.3 percent) while Japan recorded the least (0.2 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **44,894** visitors entered through Airport, among them **25,422** visitors came by international flights and **19,472** by domestic flights. The remaining **8,193** visitors entered through seaport, of which **41** visitors came by Cruise Ship and **8,152** by Sea Ferries.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **269,060** visitors from January -July, 2018 which is an increase of **27.1** percent compared with the corresponding months (January - July) 2017. Most of visitors were from Europe (**57.8** percent). In country wise, Italy (9.2 percent) is a leading market for the first seven months in Zanzibar tourism market. About **231,921** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **86.2** percent while the remaining **37,139** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **13.8** percent (**Table 3**).

Information on the purpose of visit (**Table 4**) shows that, in July 2018, about 46,874 visitors equivalent to **88.3** percent of visitors came for holidays, followed by 'visiting friend and relatives' that accounts for only nine percent.

Table 5 shows that there were **26,523** male (**50.0** percent) and **26,564** female (**50.0** percent) visitors in July, 2018. Males increased by 46.5 percent and females by 38.9 percent compared with the preceding month.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in **Table 6** show that **4,976** (9.4 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **45,809** (**86.3** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **2,302** (4.3 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that 22.3 percent of all visitors in July 2018 stayed in the country for six days. Only 1.6 percent of visitors stayed in the country for at least a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in July, 2018 was about Eight (7.8) nights.

The visitors from emerging markets increased by 0.2 percent for the month of July 2018 compared with corresponding month in 2017 and increased by 14.2 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from China increased by 29.7 percent compared with the corresponding month in 2017 and greatly increased by more than hundred percent compared with previous month. Other performances are shown in **Table 8**.

The total of **524,830** bed-spaces was available in July 2018. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of 411,930 hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **78.5** percent (**Table 10**).

Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

Definition and Concepts

Tourist: refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refers to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

(iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship;

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
