## **TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR MARCH, 2017**

#### 1. Introduction

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner. This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

# 2. Definition and Concepts

**Tourist:** refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.

### 3. Key findings

About 30,366 visitors entered Zanzibar in March, 2017 which is an increase of 4.5 percent compared to corresponding month in March 2016 and a decrease of 22.4 percent compared to previous month. Europeans remain as the largest source of visitors to Zanzibar tourism. Almost seven in every ten (68.9 percent) of all visitors entered Zanzibar in March, 2017 were from Europe. In country wise, Italians (5,616) continue to dominate the Tourism market by accounting 18.5 percent of all visitors entered in March, followed by German (10.0 percent) and Israel (6.5 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.2 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that 26,018 visitors entered Zanzibar through Airport, among them 22,123 visitors came by international flights and 3,895 by domestic flights. The remaining 4,348 visitors entered through seaport from Tanzania Mainland.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **110,423** visitors from January to March 2017 which is an increase of **16.3** percent compared to the corresponding January - March, 2016. Almost three quarters (**72.7** percent) of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (**18.3** percent) is a leading market for the first three months to Zanzibar tourism market. About **94,269** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **85.4** percent while the remaining **16,154** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **14.6** percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in March 2017, a majority of visitors 29,852 (98.3 percent) were in Zanzibar for holidays compared with only 372 (1.2 percent) and 15 (0.05 percent) of visitors who were in Zanzibar for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 5 shows that in March, 2017 there were 13,620 (44.9 percent) males and 16,746 (55.1 percent) female visitors. Comparing to the previous month males and females decreased by 20.5 percent and 23.8 percent respectively.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that 1,204 (3.96 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; 26,890 (88.6 percent) were aged 15 and 64 years and 2,272 (7.5 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (27.5 percent) stayed in the country for seven days. Only about one percent (0.9 percent) of visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in March, 2017 was almost 8 nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets increased by 27.5 percent compared to corresponding month in 2016 and decrease by 13.4 percent compared to previous month. Visitors from Poland have shown a notable increase of more than hundred percent compared with corresponding month but decreased by 24.7 percent compared with previous month. Visitors from Israel and Russia increased by 55.2 and 53.9 percent respectively compared to corresponding month and 10.7 and 5.9 percent respectively compared to the previous month. The results also shows that visitors from Ukraine, China and India declined compared to corresponding month and previous month as shown in Table 8.

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in March 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, an estimate of **235,205** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **44.2** percent. (Table 10).
