Overview

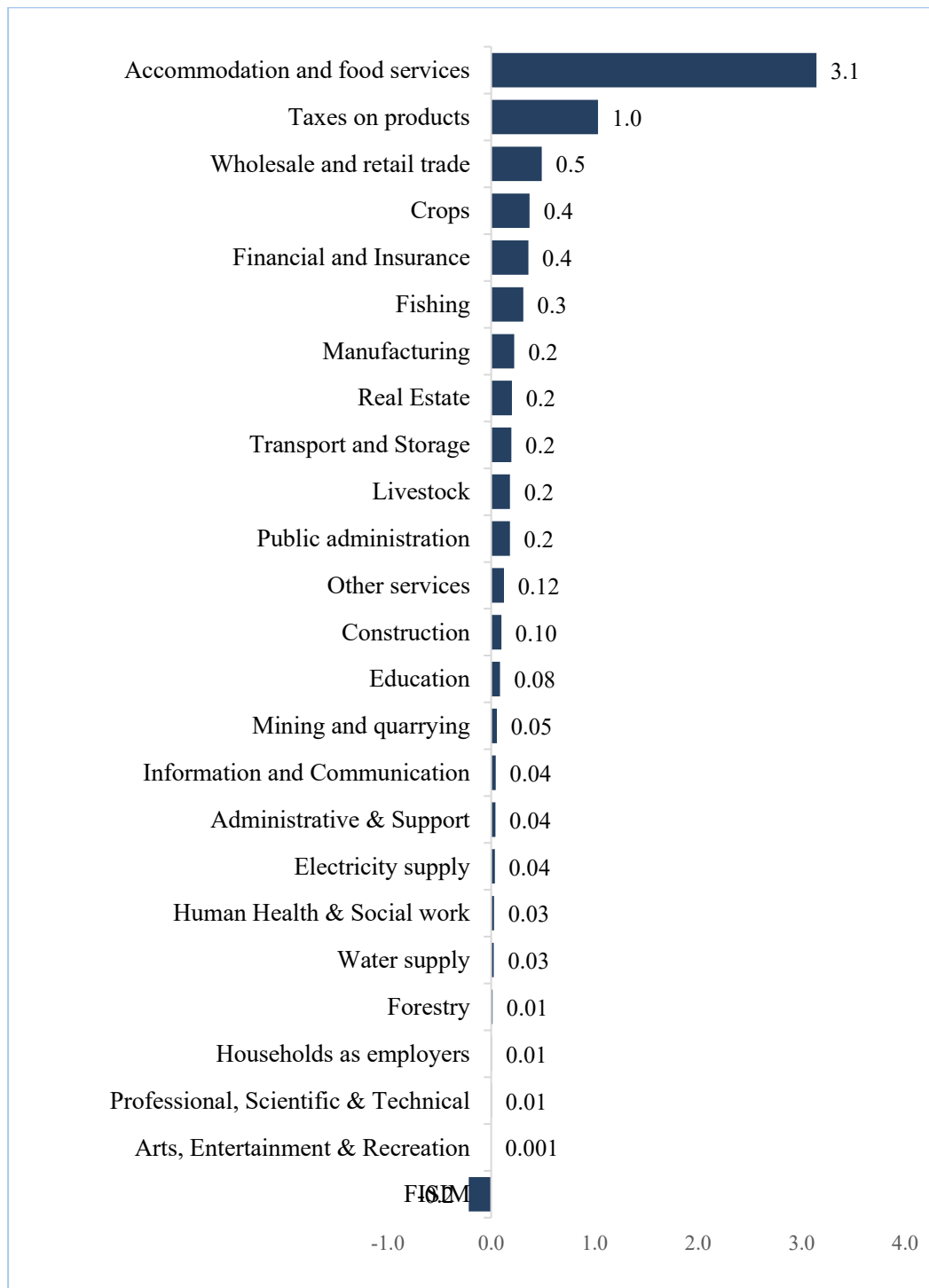
Zanzibar's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the third quarter of 2025 in volume terms increased by **7.0 percent** compared with corresponding quarter of 2024. The analysis of GDP growth by economic activity shows that Accommodation and Food Service Activities were the main contributors to overall GDP growth during the quarter, contributing 3.1 percentage points. This was followed by Taxes on Products, which contributed 1.0 percentage point, and Wholesale and Retail Trade, which contributed 0.5 percentage points.

Other notable contributions came from Crop Production and Financial and Insurance Activities, each contributing 0.4 percentage points, as well as Fishing, which contributed 0.3 percentage points. Manufacturing, Transport and Storage, Real Estate, Livestock, and Public Administration each contributed 0.2 percentage points to GDP growth.

Relatively small contributions were recorded in Construction (0.1 percentage points), Education (0.08 percentage points), Mining and Quarrying (0.05 percentage points), and Information and Communication (0.04 percentage points).

Overall, the results indicate that growth in GDP during this quarter was mainly driven by service-related activities, particularly accommodation and food services, trade, and taxes on products.

Growth of Main Sectors at Constant Prices

Agricultural sector increased by 5.4 percent due to an increase in yields of crops such as paddies, cassava, banana etc. and vegetables and fruits like watermelons and tomatoes, as well as an increase in fishery production.

The industrial sector also increased by 2.3 percent. This growth was primarily due to increases in manufacturing goods and mining and quarrying production.

The service sector grew by 8.2 percent compared with corresponding quarter, 2024. This growth came from crucial sectors including Accommodation and Food Services, Transport and Storage, Financial and Insurance, Other Services, Administrative & Support, Information and Communication, Public Administration, Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, Education, Human Health & Social work, Real Estate as well as Wholesale and retail trade.

Figure 2: Changes in percentage by economic activity to the corresponding quarter

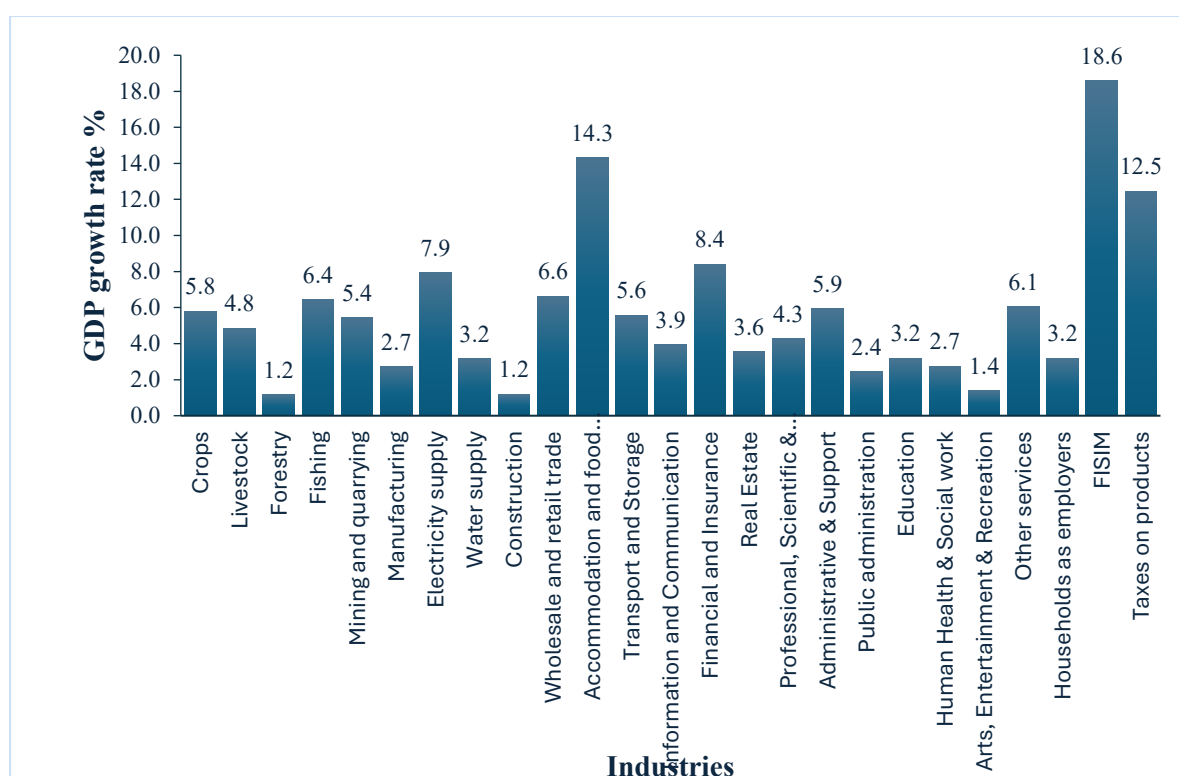


Figure 2 above shows that based on constant price, the GDP growth by economic activity indicates mixed performance across industries during this quarter. The growth observed by various economic activities where Accommodation and Food Service Activities, which increased by 14.3 percent, Taxes on Products recorded a growth of 12.5 percent, indicating increased revenue collection. Other economic activities observed are Electricity Supply (7.9 percent), Wholesale and Retail Trade (6.6 percent), Fishing (6.4 percent), Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (5.9 percent), and Crop Production (5.8 percent).

Furthermore, lower growth rates were registered in Forestry (1.2 percent), Water Supply (1.2 percent), Arts, Entertainment and Recreation (1.4 percent), Public Administration (2.4 percent), and Human Health and Social Work Activities (2.7 percent).

Performance by Main Sectors

The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing

In Q3 2025, this sector increased by 5.4 percent compare to corresponding quarter of 2024. This is due to the increase in Fishing by 6.4 percent, Crops 5.8 percent, Livestock 4.8 percent and Forestry 1.2 percent.

At current prices, Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing sector was valued at TZS 336 billion in Q3 2025, accounting for about 17.2 percent to the total GVA.

Figure 3: Growth Rates of the Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing Sector, Q1_2024 – Q3_2025

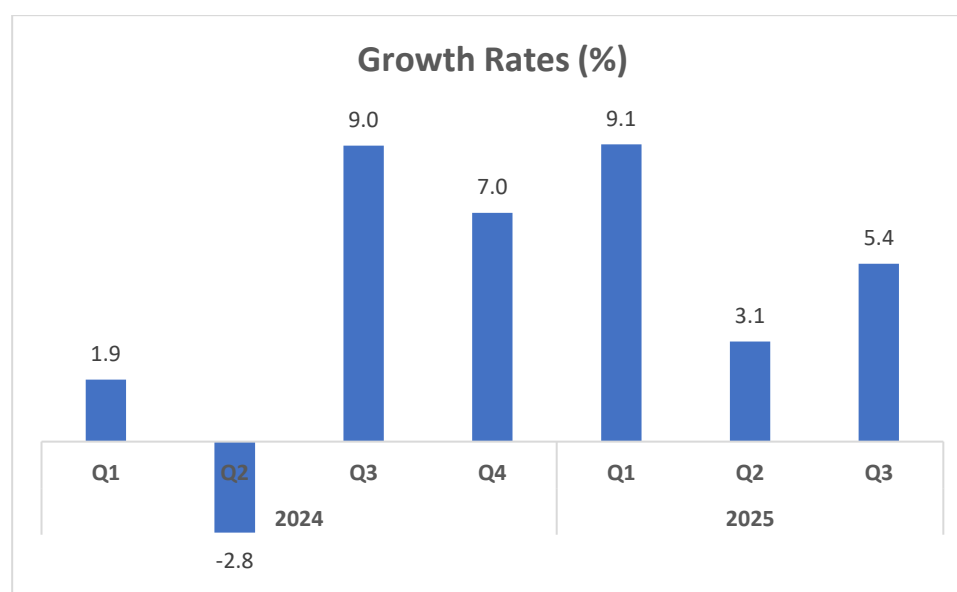

The Industrial Sector

Industrial sector has increased by 2.3 percent in Q3 2025 compare to corresponding quarter of 2024. This was mainly attributed to the increase in Electricity Supply by 7.9 percent, followed by Mining and Quarrying 5.4 percent, Water Supply 3.2 percent, Manufacturing 2.7 percent and Construction 1.2 percent.

At current prices, this sector was valued at TZS 438 billion, contributing 22.4 percent to the total GVA.

Figure 4: Growth Rates of the Industrial Sector, Q1_2024 – Q3_2025

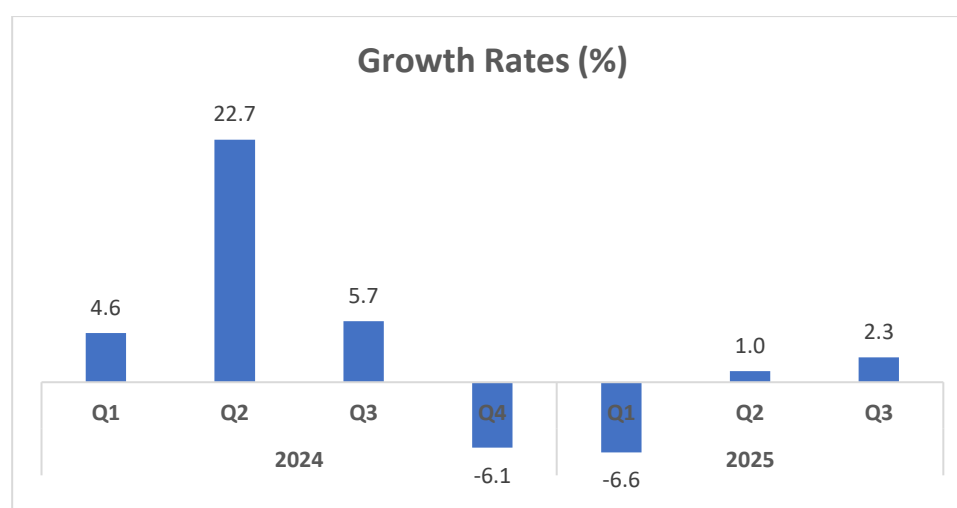

The Services Sector

The services sector has increased in this quarter by 8.2 percent compare to corresponding quarter of 2024. The positive growth was attributed by Accommodation and Food Services by 14.3 percent, followed by Financial and Insurance 8.4 percent, Wholesale and retail trade 6.6 percent, Other Services 6.1 percent, Administrative & Support 5.9 percent, Transport and Storage 5.6 percent etc.

At current prices, the services sector was valued at TZS 962 billion and contributed 49.1 per cent to the total GVA in Q3 2025.

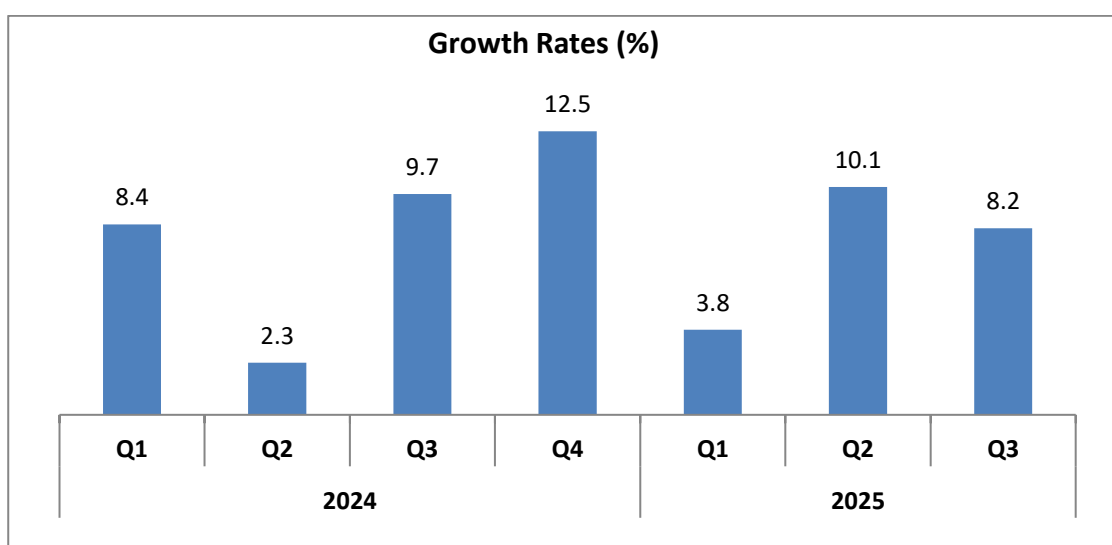
Figure 5: Growth Rates of the Services Sector, Q1_2024 – Q3_2025

Introduction

The compilation of national accounts statistics is a dynamic process and therefore needs to adapt to reflect a variety of measures and indicators consistent with developments and structural changes in the economy over a period. It is therefore expected that revisions and updates are made to the historical series on a quarterly or annual basis as new data sources are brought into the model and as various benchmarks and assumptions are validated and updated.

*This quarterly report is the 42nd published by the Office of the Chief Government Statistician of the quarterly series of GDP estimates at constant **2015** prices. This report is an ongoing publication and can also be downloaded from our website www.ocgs.go.tz.*
