### ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR FEBRUARY 2026

#### ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 4.82 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to February 2026 increased to 4.82 percent from 4.25 percent registered in January 2026. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate increased to 9.15 percent in February 2026 compared to 9.05 percent in January 2026. The overall Index increased to 120.34 in February 2026 compared to 114.80 recorded in February 2025 (Table 1).

## ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food increased to 9.30 percent for the year ended February 2026 compared to 9.18 percent recorded for the year ended January 2026. The overall index for food increased to 135.07 in February 2026 from 123.58 recorded in February 2025, while Annual inflation rate for non-food increased to 1.36 percent in February 2026 compared to 0.44 percent in January 2026, overall index for non-food increased to 110.31 in February 2026 compared to 108.83 in February 2025, (Table 2). Products contribute to increase annual inflation rate were Mbeya Rice 6.51%, Maize Flour 4.27%, Flat bread 3.79%, Fish 8.68%, Sunflower Cooking Oil 1.25%, Edible cooking Oil (OKI) 0.79%, Yellow Cooking Banana 29.14%, Green Cooking Banana 16.96% , Gas in Cylinder 0.32%, Diesel 0.24% and Petrol 4.36% (Table 3).

## MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN FEBRUARY 2026


During February 2026 the monthly headline inflation rate decreased to 0.50 percent compared to 2.30 percent recorded for the month ended January 2026. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended February 2026 decreased to negative 0.03 percent compared to 4.65 percent for the month ended January 2026 (Table 1).

The products that contribute to decrease monthly inflation rate are Thailand Rice 0.85%, Mbeya Rice 0.60%, Jasmin Rice 0.92% Wheat Flour 1.21 % , Wheat Flour 1.21%, Maize Flour 0.25%, Flatbread 0.05%, Fish 1.57%, Sunflower Oil 0.38%, Edible Cooking Oils (OKI) 0.76%, Green Cooking Banana 11.46% and White Sugar 0.07%, (Table3).



## **Explanatory Note**

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a “basket” of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
