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## **TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR MARCH, 2019**

Tourist Arrivals in Zanzibar decreased by 32.2 percent to 33,883 in March from 49,973 in February 2019 and decreased by 14.4 percent compared with corresponding month in 2018. Tourists from Europe continue to dominate the Zanzibar market by accounting 63.8 percent of the total visitors in March 2019 and decreased by 12.3 percent compared with corresponding month in 2018. In country wise, Italy dominated the Tourism market by accounting 15.3 percent of all visitors entered in March, followed by America (9.3 percent) and German (7.4 percent) while Japan recorded the least (0.3 percent). Other performances are as shown in (Table 1).

The data from table 2 shows that **29,783** visitors entered through Airport, among them **22,039** visitors came by international flights and **7,744** by domestic flights and remaining **4,100** visitors through Seaport, of which **7** came by Cruise Ship and **4,093** by Sea Ferries.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **129,989** visitors from January-March 2019 which is a decrease of **6.4** percent compared with the corresponding months (January – March) 2018. Most of visitors were from Europe (**68.0** percent). In country wise, Italy (16.2 percent) is a leading market for the first three months in Zanzibar tourism market. About **115,600** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **88.9** percent while the remaining **14,389** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **11.1** percent (**Table 3**).

Information on the purpose of visit (**Table 4**) shows that March 2019, about **31,991** visitors equivalent to **94.4** percent of visitors came for holidays.

**Table 5** shows that among the visitors there were **15,108** males (**44.6** percent) and **18,775** females (**55.4** percent) in March 2019. Males and Females decreased by 33.8 percent and 30.8 percent respectively compared with the preceding month.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in **Table 6** show that **1,667** (4.9 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **29,395** (**86.8** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years and **2,821** (8.3 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

**Table 7** shows that 29.2 percent of all visitors in March 2019 stayed in the country for Six days. Less than two percent (1.1 percent) of visitors stayed in the country for at least a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in March 2019 was about Seven (7.4) nights.

The visitors from emerging markets decreased by 56.1 percent in March 2019 compared with corresponding month in 2018 and by 52.9 percent compared with previous month. Other performances are shown in **Table 8**.

The total of **520,397** bed-spaces was available in March 2019. Out of these bed-spaces, estimates of 250,498 hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **48.1** percent (**Table 10**).

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Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the

important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's

economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner.

This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex

distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors

are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors

who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

**Definition and Concepts** 

**Tourist:**refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise

of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.(According to the United

Nations World Tourism Organization - UNWTO)

**Visitor:** refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment

for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the

exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

(i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;

(ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;

Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (excursionist) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; (iii)

and

(iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
