ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR JULY 2026

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 5.96 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to July 2026 increased to 5.96 percent from 4.05 percent registered in July 2025 while in June 2026 registered 6.01 percent. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate increased to 10.91 percent in July 2026 compared to 4.87 percent in July 2025, while June 2026 registered 10.29 percent. The overall Index increased to 123.82 in July 2026 compared to 116.86 recorded in July 2025 (Table 1).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food increased to 11.08 percent for the year ended July 2026 compared to 4.27 percent recorded for the year ended July 2025. The overall index for food increased to 141.41 in July 2026 from 127.30 recorded in July 2025, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decreased to 1.91 percent in July 2026 compared to 2.49 percent in July 2025, overall index for non-food increased to 111.84 in July 2026 compared to 109.74 in July 2025, (Table 2). Products contribute to increase annual inflation rate were Mbeya Rice 12.03%, Maize Flour 3.79%, Fish 26.22%, Green Cooking Banana 38.03%, Brown Sugar 11.29%, White Sugar 8.48%, Gas in cylinder 6.50%, Kerosene 44.70%, Diesel 33.81% and Petrol 29.84% (Table3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN JULY 2026

During July 2026 the monthly headline inflation rate decreased to 0.13 percent compared to 0.96 percent recorded for the month ended June 2026. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended July 2026 decreased to 0.61 percent compared to 1.65 percent for the month ended June 2026 (**Table 1**).

The products that contribute to decrease monthly inflation rate are wheat Flour 0.58%, Edible Cooking Oil (OKI) 0.85%, and Yellow Cooking Banana 7.09% (Table3).

Chart 1: Zanzibar Inflation Rate from July 2024 – July 2026

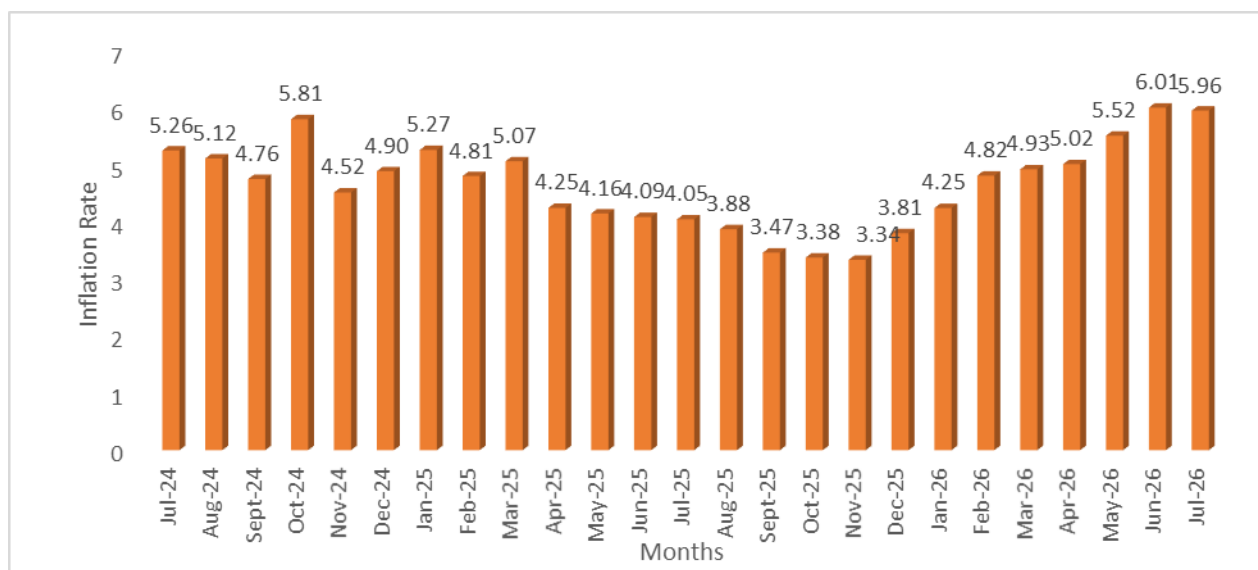
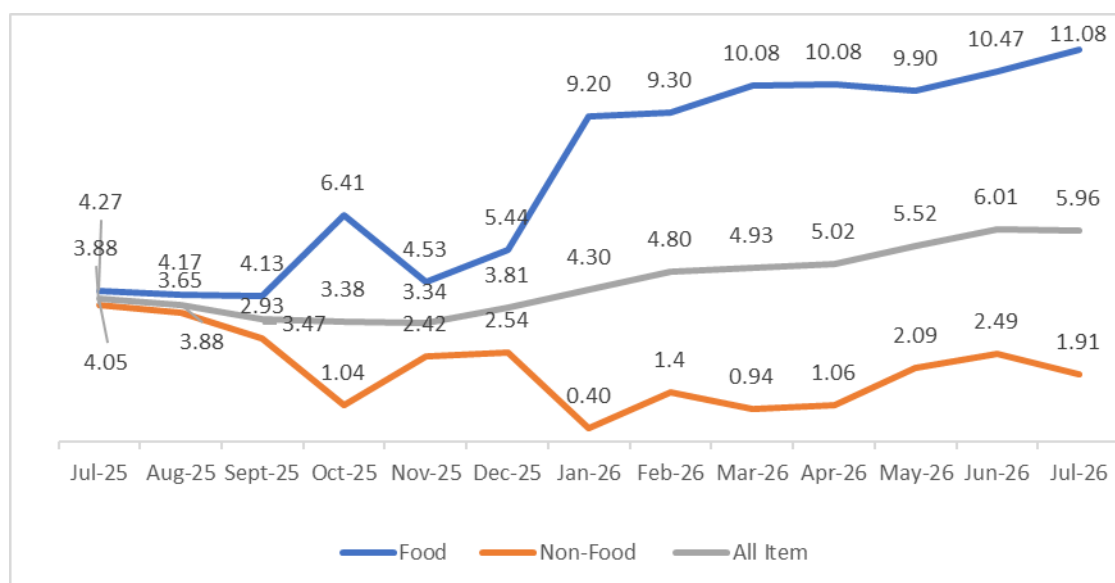


Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from July 2025 – July 2026

Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a “basket” of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
