### 1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 103,060.2 million in August 2020, decreased by 2.9 percent then the previous month and increased by more than hundred percent compared to the corresponding month of 2019.

#### 2. Exports Statistics

In August 2020, total exports decreased by 57.5 percent compared to previous month and by 82.5 percent compared to August 2019. Food and live animals section contributed 78.1 percent of the total exports (table 2).

#### 3. Exports by Top Five Partner in August 2020

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the August 2020 accounted 74.5 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destinations were Denmark (20.0 percent) and Vietnam (19.9 percent).

#### 4. Imports Statistics

In August 2020, total imports decreased by 5.2 percent compared to July 2020 and increased by 71.5 percent compared to August 2019. Machinery and transport equipment section contributed 48.3 percent of the total imports followed by mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (21.7 percent). The performance of other sections is as shown in table 4.

### 5. Imports by Top Five Partner in August 2020

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the August 2020 contributed 88.0 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from China (52.6 percent) and United Arab Emirates (25.5 percent).
