1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 40,137.0million in August 2021, decreased by 61.1 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and by 37.6 percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio increased from 3.6 percent in July 2021 to 50.3 percent in August 2021. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

August 2021 recorded a total exports value of TZS 40,589.8 million, increased by more than one hundred percent compared to August 2020 and by more than one hundred percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 98.1 percent (TZS 39,838.6 million) of the total exports in August 2021 (table2).



3. Exports by Top Five Partner in August 2021

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the August 2021 accounted 95.3 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was Singapore that accounted 78.3 percent (TZS 31,779.6 million) of the total export in August 2021(Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

August 2021 recorded a total import value of TZS 80,726.8 million, which decreased by 23.1 percent compared to August 2020 and increased by 20.9 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 40.1 percent (TZS 32,338.1 million) of the total value imported followed by Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (15.3 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for August 2021 was TZS 21,019.7 million which increased by 26.5 percent corresponding to August 2020 and decreased by 17.6 percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 17,133.3 million which decreased by 69.4 with corresponding month of 2020 and increased by 61.0 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 42,573.8 million which increased by 31.2 percent compared to corresponding month of 2020 and by 39.1 percent compared to previous month (Table 4).



6. Imports by Top Five Partner in August 2021

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the August 2021 contributed 75.4 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (44.4 percent, TZS 35,873.1 million).
