#### 1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 76,513.8 million in December 2020, increased by 7.9 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2019 and by 58.5 percent compared with the previous month. (Table 1).

#### 2. Exports Statistics

December 2020 recorded a total exports value of 3,439.8 million, decreased by 77.5 percent compared to December 2019 and increased by 73.4 percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 82.2 percent of the total exports in December 2020 (table 2).

## 3. Exports by Top Five Partner in December 2020

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the December 2020 accounted 87.9 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was India that accounted 37.3 percent of the total export in December 2020.

#### 4. Imports Statistics

December 2020 recorded a total import value of 79,953.5 million, which decreased by 7.3 percent compared to December 2019 and increased by 59.1 percent compared to previous month. Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 36.0 percent of the

total value imported followed by Machinery and transport equipment (24.1 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 4.

#### 5. Import by Categories

December 2020 imported value of consumer goods was 19,362.1 which increased by 24.6 percent compared to December 2019 and by 22.5 percent compared to previous month. Imports value of capital goods was 25,624.7 which decreased by 21.5 compared with corresponding month of 2019 and increased by more than hundred percent compared to the previous month and Imported value of intermediary goods was 34,966.7 which decreased by 8.0 percent compared to corresponding month of 2019 and increased by 33.5 percent compared to previous month (Table 6).

## 6. Imports by Top Five Partner in December 2020

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the December 2020 contributed 72.1 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (36.3 percent) and China (18.6 percent).
