#### 1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 91,415.8 million in February 2022, increased by 5.3 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and by 36.2 percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio decreased from 27.1 percent in January 2021 to 8.2 percent in February 2022. (Table 1).

## 2. Exports Statistics

February 2022 recorded a total exports value of TZS 8,169.2 million, increased by 95.6 percent compared to February 2021 and decreased by 67.3 percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 83.3 percent (TZS 6,805.4 million) of the total exports in February 2022 (table 2).



# 3. Exports by Top Five Partner in February 2022

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the February 2022 accounted 81.3 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was India that accounted 48.1 percent (TZS 3,932.4 million) of the total export in February 2022(Figure 1).

# 4. Imports Statistics

February 2021 recorded a total import value of TZS 99,584.9 million, which increased by 9.5 percent compared to February 2021 and by 8.1 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 28.9 percent (TZS 28,802.2 million) of the total value imported followed by Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (22.2 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

## 5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for February 2022 was TZS 29,660.5 million, which increased 64.6 percent, compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and by 5.4 percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 26,557.7 million which decreased by 29.2 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and increased by 62.0 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 43,366.7 million that increased by 22.3 percent compared to corresponding month of 2021 and decreased by 8.9 percent compared to previous month (Table 4).
