1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 111,327.0 million in August 2022, increased by more than hundred percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and by 33.8 percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio increased from 5.1 percent in July 2022 to 9.9 percent in August 2022. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

August 2022, recorded a total exports value of TZS 12,167.1 million, decreased by 70.0 percent compared to August 2021 and increased by more than hundred percent compared with the previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 91.1 percent (TZS 11,087.5 million) of the total exports in August 2022 (table 2).



3. Exports by Top Five Partner in August 2022

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the August 2022 accounted 89.9 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was Singapore that accounted 77.0 percent (TZS 9,374.3 million) of the total export in August 2022 (Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

August 2022 recorded a total import value of TZS 123,494.1 million, which increased by 53.0 percent compared to August 2021 and by 40.9 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 47.7 percent (TZS 58,942.9 million) of the total value imported followed by Food and live animals (18.5 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for August 2022 was TZS 40,790.4 million which increased by 94.1 percent compared to corresponding month and by more than hundred percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 16,085.0 million which decreased by 6.1 percent compared to the corresponding month and increased by 6.4 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 66,618.6 million which increased by 56.5 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and by 9.0 percent compared to previous month. (Table 4).



6. Imports by Top Five Partner in August 2022

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the August 2022 contributed 80.3 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (50.6 percent, TZS 62,471.2 million).
