1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 83,708.9 million in September 2022, increased by more than hundred percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and decreased by 24.8 percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio increased from 9.9 percent in August 2022 to 24.8 percent in September 2022. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

September 2022, recorded a total exports value of TZS 27,562.3 million, decreased by 50.8 percent compared to September 2021 and increased by more than hundred percent compared with the previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 96.1 percent (TZS 26,480.3 million) of the total exports in September 2022 (table 2).



3. Exports by Top Five Partner in September 2022

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the September 2022 accounted 95.1 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was Singapore that accounted 57.9 percent (TZS 15,949.4 million) of the total export in September 2022 (Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

September 2022 recorded a total import value of TZS 111,271.2 million, which increased by 26.1 percent compared to September 2021 and decreased by 9.9 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 39.6 percent (TZS 44,068.3 million) of the total value imported followed by Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (14.1 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for September 2022 was TZS 23,610.0 million which increased by 45.5 percent compared to corresponding month and decreased by 42.1 percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 23,145.3 million which decreased by 7.3 percent compared to the corresponding month and increased by 43.9 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 64,515.9 million which increased by 37.1 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2021 and decreased by 3.2percent compared to previous month. (Table 4).



6. Imports by Top Five Partner in September 2022

The top five trading partners for imported goods in the September 2022 contributed 74.3 percent of the total import. Imports were mainly from United Arab Emirates (47.2 percent, TZS 52,537.2 million).
