



1. External Trade Performance.

Total trade for the third quarter, 2022 reached to TZS 366,637.7 million; in which exports value worth TZS 44,198.1 million (domestic export contributes TZS 41,542.4 million and re-export contributes 2,655.7 TZS million) and import worth TZS 322,439.6 million. The trade balance showed a deficit of TZS 278,241.5 million (Table 1; figure 1).



The trend indicates that, total exports decreased by 55.4 compared with corresponding quarter and increased by more than one hundred percent compared with previous quarter. Imports value increased by 36.8 percent compared with corresponding quarter and decreased by 12.9 compared by previous quarter (Figure 2).




2. Exports Statistics

2.1. Exports by SITC section

The value of exports includes 'Export of goods for direct home use, Re-export after outright importation, Re-export after temporary import of goods on hire purchase and re-export after customers warehousing procedure.


In the third quarter of 2022, food and live animals section contributed 89.6 percent of the total exports followed by Machinery and Transport Equipment (6.3 percent). (Figure 3 and table 2).



2.2. Exports of Main Cash Crops


A total of 1,827.2 tons, valued at TZS 34,296.1 million of cloves have exported in the third quarter of 2022, showing decreasing value by 62.2 percent compared with corresponding and increasing by more than one hundred percent with the previous quarter (Figure 4 and table 3).

Exports of cloves contributed 77.6 percent of the total export value, which have exported on three countries as shown in figure 4.




A total of 2,093.2 tons, valued at TZS 2,518.8 million of Seaweeds were exported in the third quarter of 2022, showing a decreasing value of 13.8 percent compared with the corresponding quarter of 2021 and by 24.2 percent with the previous quarter (Figure 5 and table 3).

Exports of Seaweeds contributed 5.7 percent of the total export value, which have exported on about six countries as shown in figure 5.



The trend shows that the exported value of cloves in third quarter 2021 was higher than in third quarter of 2022, however exported value of cloves in third quarter 2022 was higher than in first and second quarter of 2022. The value of seaweed exported had decreased from the first quarter of 2022 to third quarter of 2022. (Figure 6 and table 3).



2.3. Exports by Top Ten Countries of Destination

The top Ten trading partners for exported goods in the third quarter of 2022 accounted 96.8 percent of the total value of exported goods. Singapore was leading partner followed by Indonesia (Figure 7).



3. Imports Statistics

The value of imports includes 'Importation for direct home use (duty and tax fully paid)', 'Importation by, or solely for use in Zanzibar' and other importation procedure (Excludes all transfer goods).

3.1. Imports by SITC Section

In the third quarter of 2022, Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials contributed 47.4 percent and food and live animals contributed 12.2 percent of the total import, the performance of other categories as shown in figure 8 and table 6.

3.2. Import by Categories






Figure 9: Percent Distribution of Import Value by Broad Economic Categories, Q3, 2022.

In the Third quarter, import of intermediate goods reached to TZS 181,889.0 million of total import (56.4 percent) while capital goods reached to TZS 54,348.6 million (16.9 percent) and import of consumer goods reached to TZS 86,202.1 million (26.7 percent) (Figure 9 and table 7).

Trend shows the imported value of consumer goods and intermediary goods for the third quarter of 2022 increased compared with corresponding and previous quarter while imported value of capital goods increased compared with corresponding quarter and decreased compared with previous quarter. 3.3. Imports by Country of Origin


The top ten trading partners for imported goods in the third quarter of 2022 contributed a value of TZS 290,569.6 million, equivalents to 90.1 percent of the total import. United Arab Emirates was the top by accounting 52.7 percent of the value of the imported goods. (Figure 11 and table 8).



4. Transferred goods

A total of goods worth TZS 4,971.4 million transferred to Tanzania Mainland from Zanzibar in the third quarter of 2022 (Figure 12). The highest percent (33.5 percent, TZS 1,370.8 million) of the total value of transferred goods were Machinery and transport equipment while the lowest percent (1.8 percent, TZS 964.1 million) were Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials. The performance of other transferred goods as shown in figure 12 and Table 9.

The trend shows that value of transferred goods to Tanzania Mainland for the third quarter decreased compared with corresponding quarter of 2021 (Figure 13 and Table 9).
