### TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2016

#### 1. Introduction

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner. This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration Cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

#### 2. Definition and Concepts

**Tourist:** refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO).

**Visitor<sup>1</sup>:** refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight – comprising of tourists entered the country direct from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight – comprising of tourists entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (**excursionist**) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries – comprising of tourists entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.

<sup>1</sup> Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home

### **3. Key findings**

About 14,701 visitors entered Zanzibar in April, 2016 which is an increase of 5.4 percent compared to corresponding month in April 2015 and a decrease of 49.4 percent compared to previous month. Europeans remain as the largest source of visitors to Zanzibar tourism. Forty three percent of the visitors (43 percent) who entered Zanzibar in April, 2016 were from Europe. In country wise, Israel (2,451) dominated the Tourism market by accounting 16.7 percent of all visitors entered in April, 2016 followed by South African (9.2 percent) and German (8.1 percent) while New Zealand continued to record the least (0.2 percent). In contrast, Italy which is the giant tourism market source in Zanzibar throughout the year, dropped to 13<sup>th</sup> position from 7<sup>th</sup> in the corresponding month in 2015. Inadequate marketing and emerging of nearby tourism markets for Italians, like Mozambique, Mauritius and Seychelles are among the reasons of dropping Italian market in Zanzibar. Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that 11,983 visitors entered Zanzibar through Airport, among them 9,120 visitors came by international flights and 2,863 by domestic flights. The remaining 2,718 visitors entered through seaport by ferry boat from Tanzania Mainland.

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 3) shows that, in April 2016, a majority of visitors 14,372 (97.8 percent) were in Zanzibar for holidays compared with only 142 (1.0 percent) and 70(0.5 percent) of visitors who were in Zanzibar for 'visiting friends and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 4 shows that in April, 2016 there were 6,163 (41.9 percent) males and 8,538 (58.1 percent) female visitors. Comparing to the previous month males decreased by 45.4 percent while females decreased by 52.0 percent.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 5 show that 1,023 (7.0 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; 12,845 (87.4 percent) were aged 15 and 64 years and 833 (5.7 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 6 shows that majority of the visitors in April stayed in the country for seven and six days while only two percent (2.1 percent) of them stayed for more than a month. The overall average length of stay for visitor in April, 2016 was 7.4 nights which is equal to that of previous month.

Generally, the number of visitors from emerging market increased by almost sixty percent (59.4 percent) compared to corresponding month in 2015 and decreased by 2.6 percent compared to previous month. Visitors from Ukraine significantly increased by more than hundred percent compared to corresponding month but decreased by 54.3 percent compared previous month. Moreover visitors from Russia, Poland and Israel increased compared to corresponding month in 2015 but decreased compared to previous month as shown in the table 7. In contrast, visitors from China and India decreased by 10.9 percent and 18.9 percent respectively compared to corresponding month. ( See table 7 below)
