### **TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR JULY, 2017**

#### **1. Introduction**

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner. This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

#### **2. Definition and Concepts**

**Tourist:** refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

**Visitor:** refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (**excursionist**) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.

### 3. Key findings

About **41,034** visitors entered Zanzibar in July, 2017 which is an increase of 9.3 percent compared to corresponding month in July 2016 and an increase of 74.9 percent compared to previous month. Europeans remain as the largest source of visitors to Zanzibar tourism. About Fifty Eight (58.9 percent) of all visitors entered Zanzibar in July, 2017 were from Europe. In country wise, British (4,314) continue to dominate the Tourism market by accounting 10.5 percent of all visitors entered in July, followed by German (8.2 percent) and American (7.9 percent) while Japanese recorded the least (0.3 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that 32,429 visitors entered Zanzibar through Airport, among them 20,599 visitors came by international flights and 11,830 by domestic flights. The remaining 8,605 visitors entered through seaport.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **211,615** visitors from January to July 2017 which is an increase of **16.7** percent compared to the corresponding months January - July, 2016. Almost 63.5 percent of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (**11.5** percent) is a leading market for the first seven months to Zanzibar tourism market. About **174,623** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **82.5** percent while the remaining **36,992** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **17.5** percent ( Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in July 2017, a majority of visitors 40,150 (97.5 percent) were in Zanzibar for holidays compared with only 682 (1.6 percent) and 21 (0.05 percent) of visitors who were in Zanzibar for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 5 shows that in July, 2017 there were 18,137 (44.2 percent) males and 22,897 (55.8 percent) female visitors. Comparing to the previous month males and females increased by 76.0 percent and 74.1 percent respectively.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that 2,369 (8.0 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; 36,055 (87.9 percent) were aged 15 and 64 years and 1,710 (4.2 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (26.5 percent) stayed in the country for seven days. Only one percent (1.0 percent) of visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in July, 2017 was Eight (8) nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of July increased by 7.5 percent compared to corresponding month in July, 2016 and increased by 80.9 percent compared to previous month. Visitors from Russian have shown a notable increase for both corresponding month (27.7 percent) and previous month (32.2 percent). Other performance are shown in Table 8.

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in July 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, an estimate of **331,746** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **62.3** percent.(Table 10).
