Introduction

Office of the Chief Government Statistician (OCGS), under the mandate bestowed to it, collects and compiles data from various institutions, including Ministries and departments. Data sources for transport statistics encompass Zanzibar Port Corporation (ZPC), Zanzibar Airport Aviation (ZAA), Zanzibar Revenue Board (ZRB) and the Department responsible for Transport and Licensing.

The transport statistical report presents statistics and information on the number of movements and trips (enter/exit), as well as traffic handling of passengers and cargo, both on airports and seaports. It also includes information on the number of motor vehicles registration and licenses issued to public and private automobile.

It is in the belief of OCGS that Quarterly estimates of transport statistics will find great use to the Government as well as the Private sector as inputs in assessing volume and directions of transportation, planning and transport policy reviews. The statistics will also serve as a motivation towards developing the transport management system in Zanzibar.

Traffic Handled at Zanzibar Seaports

Table.1 shows that 38 trips (enter/exit) were made by foreign vessels in the second quarter (April–June) 2017, which shows an increases by 36 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by three percent compared with previous quarter. Total Growth Registered Tone (GRT) recorded by foreign vessels reached 540,786 increases by 22 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline three percent compared with previous quarter. The local vessels made were 865 trips in the second quarter of 2017 decline by six percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and three percent compared with previous quarter.

The number of passengers entered Zanzibar through seaports in the second quarter (April – June) 2017 reached 294,524 increases by 2 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and 8 percent compared with previous quarter. Subsequently, a total of 270,965 passengers left (outbound) Zanzibar through seaports 277,410 passenger decline by three percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and increases by two percent compared with previous quarter.

The total imported weight of general cargo and from dhows through seaports in the second quarter (April-June) 2017 reached 91,492 tones increases by 75 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and 22 percent compared with previous quarter. The number of Teus of container 9,491 imported during the second quarter which shows no change compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and 17 percent compared with previous quarter.

On the side of exports, total weight of general cargo and from dhows was 15,861 tones which are higher by 23 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by 45 percent compared with previous quarter. A total of 9,520 teus of containers were exported during the second quarter which shows no changes compared with the corresponding quarter of 2016 and increases by 11 percent compared with previous quarter.

Aircraft Movements

Table.2 shows that, 2,060 international aircraft movements were recorded in the second quarter (April-June) 2017, of which 1,024 were arrivals and 1,036 were departures. This indicates a remarkable increase of 15.5 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by 13 percent compared with previous quarter. On the other side, a total domestic aircraft movements recorded is 14,773 (enter/ exit) whereby, 7390 were arrivals and 7,383 were departure. This increases 4.8 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and lower by 13 percent compared with previous quarter.

The number of passengers embarked Zanzibar through airports by international flights in the first quarter (April – June) 2017, reached 53,243 which is higher by 43.2 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and lower by 47 percent compared with previous quarter, while 49,559 passengers disembarked in the same quarter showing an increase of 49 percent

compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline 40 percent compared with previous quarter. On the other side, total of 44,377 passengers embarked Zanzibar using domestic flights in the second quarter 2017 increases by 3.5 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by 22 percent compared with previous quarter, while 54,165 passengers increases by 6.1 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by 20 percent compared with previous quarter.

A total of 10.79 tones were loaded by international flights in the second quarter, 2017 which shows an increases of 17.3 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and decline by 11 percent compared with previous quarter, while a total of 324.16 tones were unloaded showing an increase of 0.2 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and increases by 12 percent compared with previous quarter.

Vehicle Registration

The registration of vehicles includes motor cycle and three wheelers (which comprises of Pedal cycle, Moped/Mate/Motor cycle), estate cars and station wagons (comprises of passengers car and light passengers vehicle), Pick - up Van and box bodies (comprises of Medium passengers car and heavy passengers), Buses and Lories and Tractors, Ambulances, trailers and others.

Table 3 shows that a total of 3,669 vehicles were registered in the second quarter, 2017 which is lower by 25 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and 12 percent compared with previous quarter.

Out of 3,669 registered vehicles, 1,600 vehicles were motor cycle and three wheelers which show to decline by 33 percent compared with the corresponding quarter of 2016 and 11 percent compared with previous quarter.

The registration of motor car, estate car and station wagon decline by five percent compared with corresponding quarter 2016 and 14 percent compared with previous quarter. The least number of vehicles registered are buses and Lorries (100), decline by 25 percent compared with corresponding quarter of 2016 and six percent compared with previous quarter.
