### **ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR JANUARY 2024**

## **ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 5.26 PERCENT**

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to January 2024 decreased to 5.26 percent from 5.48 percent registered in December 2023. This was mainly driven by the decreased in the prices of commodities under; Transport Division inflation rate decrease by 3.17 percent in January 2024 compared to 6.70 percent in December 2023. The overall Index increased to 109.11 in January 2024 compared to 103.65 recorded in January 2023 (**Table1**).

#### ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food is increased to 9.21 percent for the year ended January 2024 compared to 8.78 percent recorded for the year ended December 2023. The overall index for food increased to 116.02 in January 2024 from 106.24 recorded in January 2023, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decreased to 2.46 percent in January 2024 compared to 3.15 percent in December 2023, overall index for non-food increased to 104.40 in January 2023 compared to 101.89 in January 2023, (Table 2). Products contribute to decrease annual inflation rate were Mbeya Rice 9.9%, Wheat Flour 1.4%, Maize Flour 4.3%, Green Cooking Banana 10.9%, Fish 0.7%, Edible Cooking Oils (OKI) 18.7% and Petrol 2.9%. ## **MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN JANUARY 2024**

During January 2024 the monthly headline inflation rate is increased to 1.50 percent compared to 0.01 percent recorded for the month ended December 2023. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended January 2024 increased to 2.55 percent compared to negative 0.18 percent for the month ended December 2023 (**Table 1**).

The products that contribute monthly inflation rate to increase are Mbeya Rice 2.8%, Jasmin Rice 1.6%, Fish 4.0%, Yellow cooking banana 8.3%, Green cooking banana 7.3%, Brown Sugar 4.1% and White Sugar 3.5%. (Table 3).

## **Explanatory Note**

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
